


Mathematics Comparison

Percentage (%) of students meeting and exceeding standards Little falls township public schools to new jersey






Grade 3 Performance level analysis




Grade 4 Performance level analysis












Algebra I Performance level analysis



Mathematics Cohort Achievement and Growth Same students, consecutive grades % Meeting + Exceeding




Special Education Mathematics Cohort Achievement and Growth Same students, consecutive grades


What changes will be implemented for Mathematics in 2018-19...
