2020-2021 Return to School

Schedule- Students In person

Monday - Friday

Drop Off: 8:30-9:00 Parents drop off students at the Garrabrant Ave gate.

Morning Meeting/SEL: 9:00-9:15

Instructional day: 9:15-1:15

Pick Up: 1:15-2:00 Parents pick up their child at their HIVE door.

Entry Doors and Hives

First Floor Classrooms- Green Hive, entry door nearest playground

Second Floor Classrooms-Yellow Hive, entry door nearest office

Third Floor Classrooms- Green Hive, entry door nearest playground

Sick students being sent home from the nurse will utilize the Green Hive stairwell and door, to be sanitized after student leaves, supervised by the nurse.

Students moving to the gym from the green hive will utilize the first floor access hallway. Yellow hive will use the second floor access hallway.

Cleaning and Safety

Custodians utilize an hour rotation where all touchpoints and bathrooms are cleaned every hour.

In between, any cleaning that will need to be done (sick child leaves building, in between indoor recess, sanitization of student materials, etc) will be on an as needed basis and communicated through walkie talkie.

STUDENTS: Wash hands upon entering classrooms, before/after snack, before/after recess, anytime they sneeze/cough/blow nose, etc. Sanitize in between at desk or using pumps.

Arrival Procedures

All students will enter through the Garrabrant Ave gate. Students will be assigned to a hive based on their homeroom teacher's floor (see previous slide). Students will be given a mask and will need to sanitize hands while entering the building.

They enter the building through their hive door and go immediately to their floor and classroom. They will put their belongings at their desk and wash hands before heading back to their seat to engage in independent activities including any virtual specials work. These activities cannot be shared between students. Supplies will be stored in personal bins at each student desk.

Dismissal Procedures

Parents will wait for students outside their child's assigned hive. Parents will have informed teachers in advance of their time frame for pickup:

- 1:15
- 1:30
- 1:45

Students will be brought down by HR teachers and hallway helpers accordingly.

In Class Learning

Each day, there will be the following instruction:

- 1.5 hours of ELA
- 1 hour of Math
- 30 minutes of either Sci or SS
- 15 minutes of SEL
- 30 minutes Specials
- 30 minutes snack/recess

Masks must be worn at all times unless a medical note had been provided.

Virtual Learning - Specials

All specials will host a virtual class for students in 3-4.

Physical Education, Music, Art, Health, SEL

Each specials teachers will create monthly units that are assigned to the children at the start of the month. Units will end with a culminating activity at the end of the month. Units will be relevant and therapeutic.

Snack/Recess

There will be a 30 minute Snack/Recess period built into the day.

Half the class will be eating snack while the other goes to recess and then it switches.

The recess blocks will be separated by hive so there will be no contamination even in inclement weather.

Students must stay at their desk for snack. At recess, they will not share equipment and stay within their own personal space. They may bring equipment from home and school will also be providing chalk. Mr. Schmidt will have suggested activities for students who might be lost without the ability to roam free.

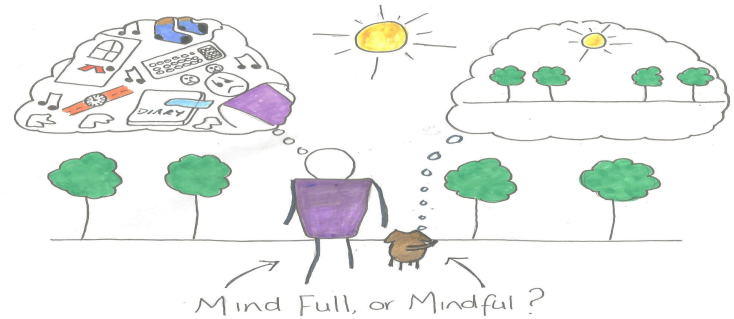
SEL: Social Emotional Learning

Example 100% Virtual Schedule: Classroom of 20-30 students

students will be live 2-4 times daily. Students will be broken into *flexible* groups.

Monday-Thursday:

9:00- 9:30 Whole class zoom 2-4 times a week - morning meeting, check in, share, set weekly goals for virtual learning, whole group mini lesson for Sci and SS

9:30-12:00- Small group ELA (Mon, Wed) Math (Tues, Thurs)
30-45 minutes each group

12:00-12:30- Specials in whole group

12:30-3:00- Small group Math (Mon, Wed) ELA (Tues, Thurs)
30-45 minutes each group

Through the day when not meeting in small group:
assignments, specials projects, SS/Sci projects

Friday: (medium groups of 8-15 students, 4 total for each partner pair) for Sci and SS:

9:00-9:30 Friday Meeting with Mrs. Dilkes

9:30- 12:00- medium Sci (2 groups) HR A & medium group SS (2 groups) HR B

12:00-12:30 Specials in whole group

12:30-3:00- medium group SS (2 groups) HR A & medium group Sci (2 groups) HR B

Small: 2-6 students

Medium: 8-15 students

Whole: 20-30 students
